



Active Shooter Instructor

This course will prepare patrol officers to respond to active shooter incidents, a situation in which time-critical tactical functions to locate, isolate and neutralize the threat must be completed in order to save civilian lives and keep police personnel alive. Scenarios include schools, workplaces, and public arenas.

Topics covered:

- Lessons learned from school, workplace, and public environment shootings
- First responder tactics
- Determining the threat
- Use of site surveys to aid preplanned responses
- Command, control, communications, and intelligence (C3I) issues
- Development of a Patrol Response Team (PRT)
- Use of a mobile Tactical Operations Center (TOC)
- Containment and isolation
- Tactical room entry and clearing
- Breaching with the tactical shotgun
- Shields and other bulletproof materials
- Issues concerning the use of counter-snipers
- Practical drills
- Low light issues
